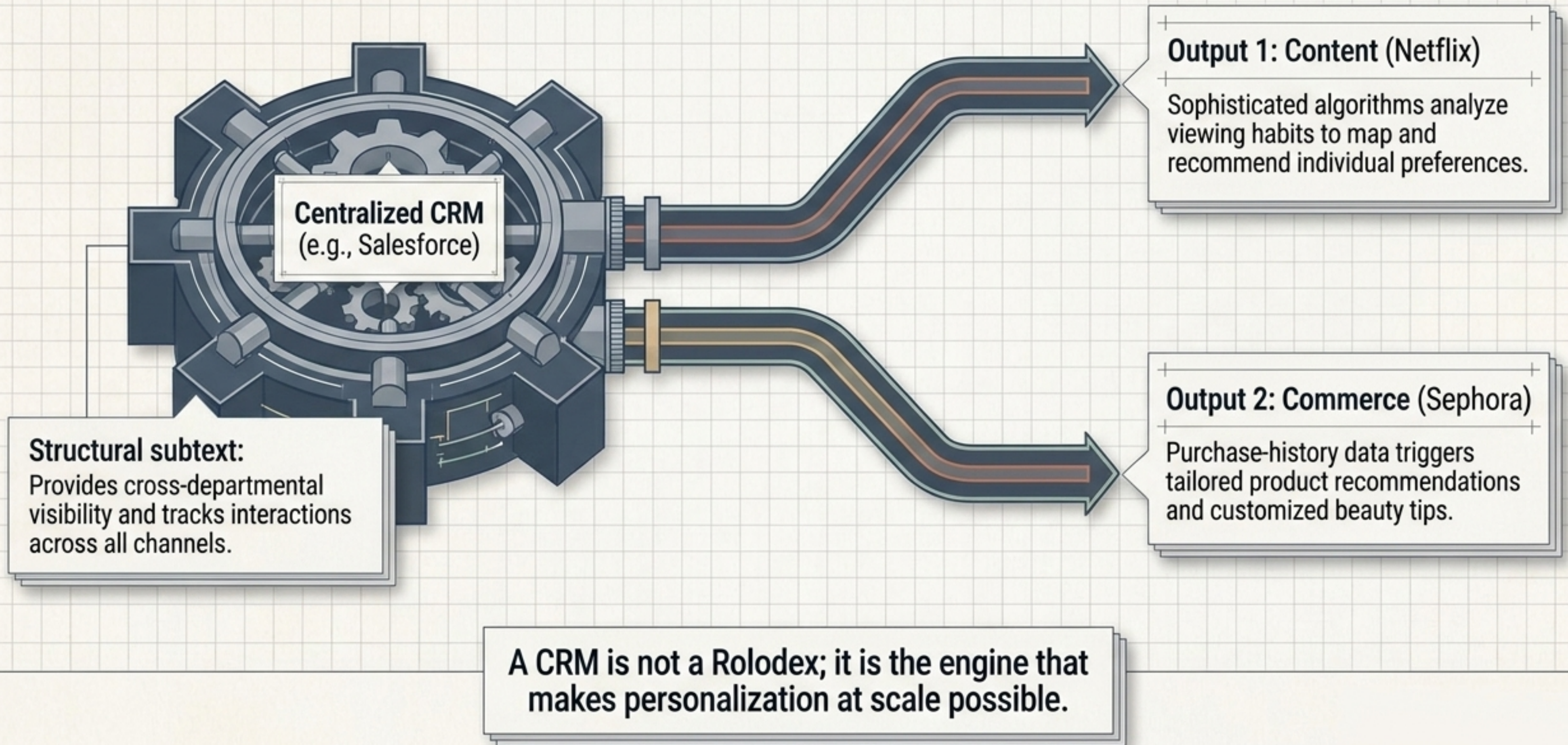
Best-in-class retention requires aligning human empathy with systematic intelligence.

Pillar 2 – Intelligence: The Data Engine

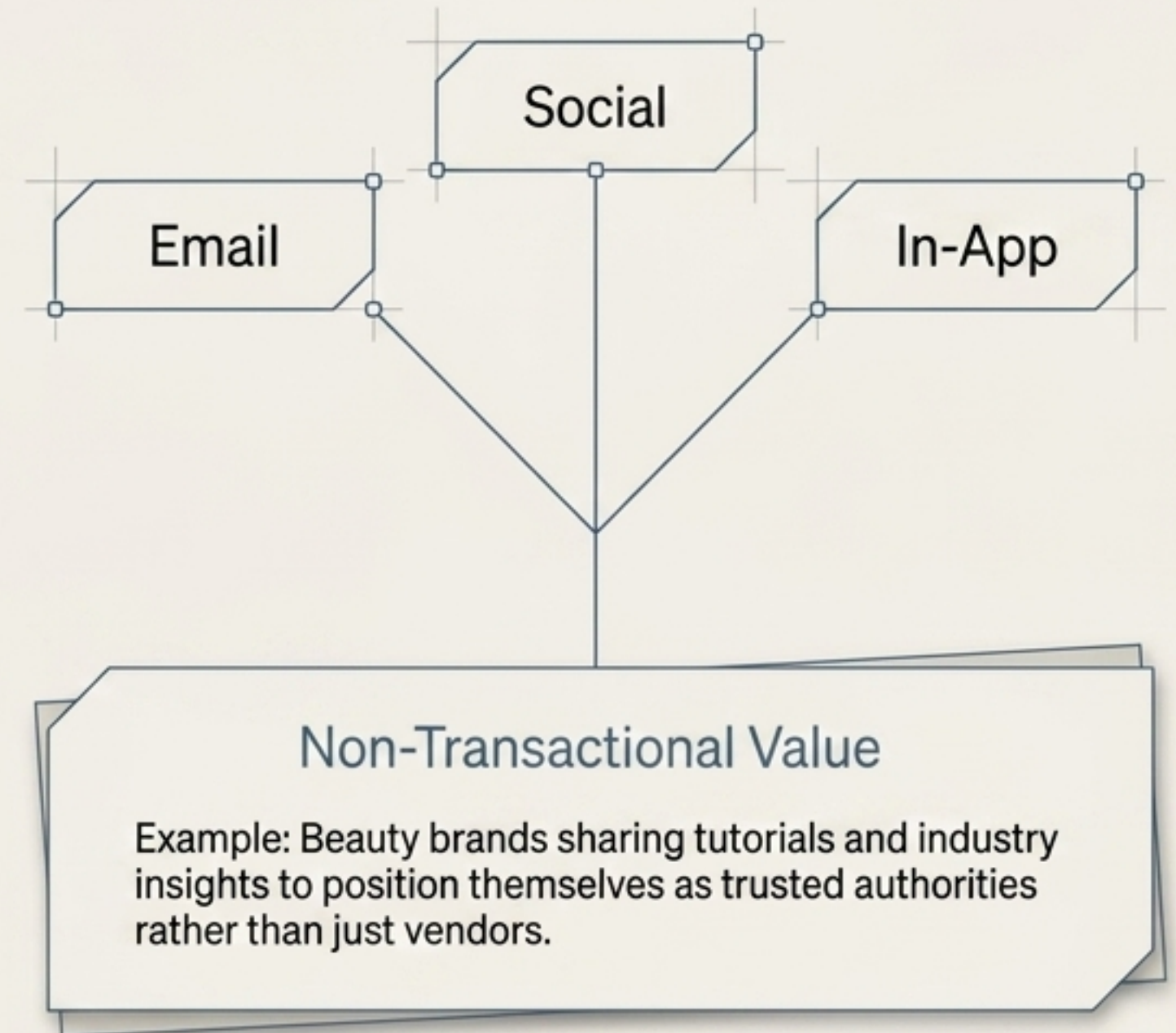

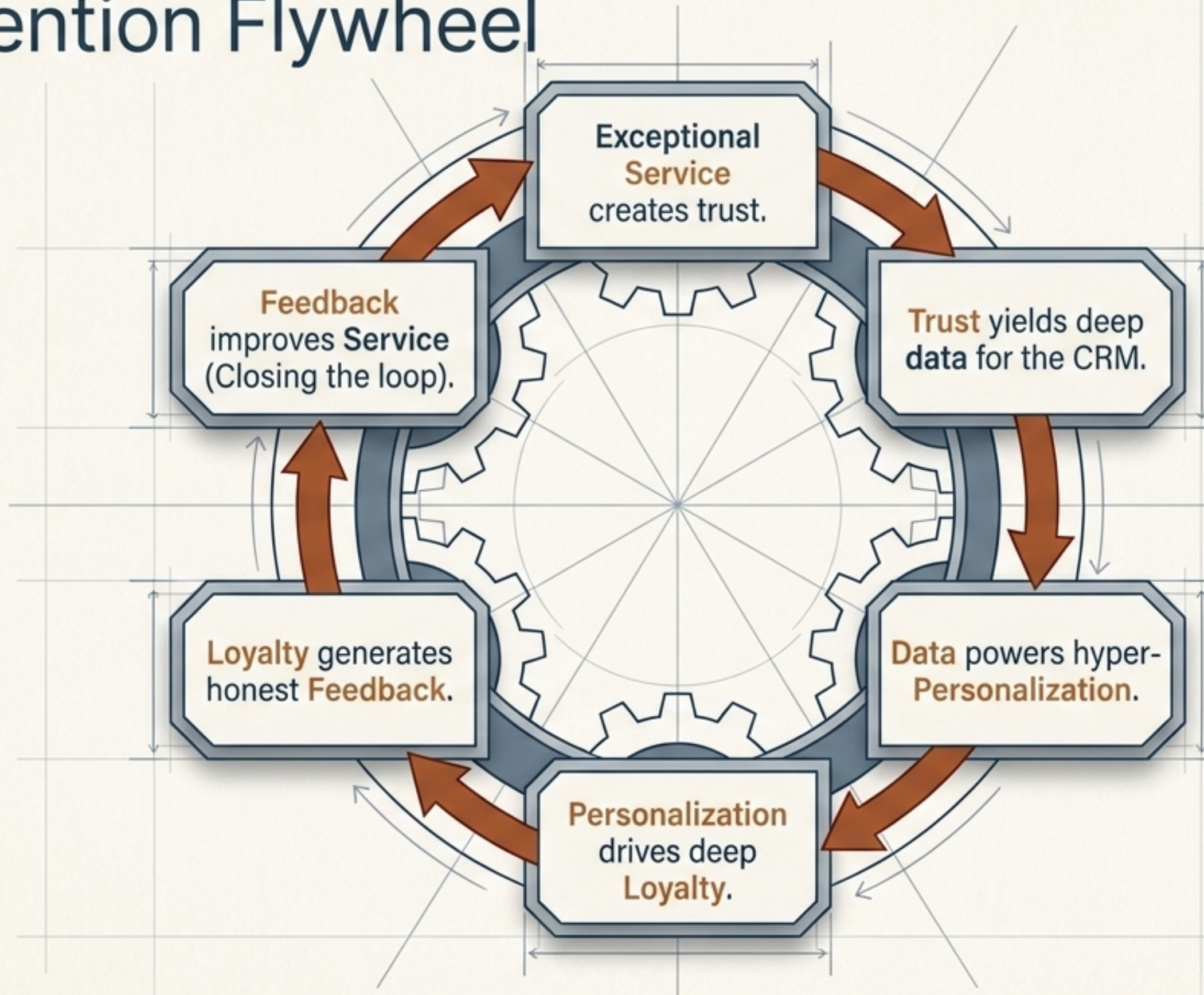

- ☐ Upgrade loyalty programs from basic points to exclusive experiences (The Nike model).
